

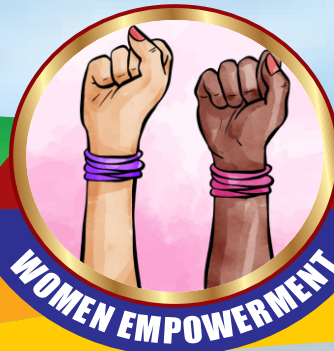

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ORIGIN & THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ORGANISATION:-

GENESIS

ManavVikas Sansthan Khairi (MVSK) is a success story of Sunil Kumar's vision. His pioneer role in reaching out to the marginalized of all sections of society became a cornerstone for MVSK, Madhubani. This became a movement and has been his long-cherished dream to help the helpless and give voice to the voiceless through education, rights and justice. His instrumental role in the struggle of land rights issues, the Bhudan land ceiling became a cornerstone in the case of KAMLA EMBANKMENT 1995-96. His constant struggle against injustice brought him the tag of a mass leader and he finally relinquished all fall charges against him by the state government. He has been associated with organizations like OXFAM, and HELPAGAE India between 2004 and 2007 further cementing his vision and efforts for the critical contribution towards inclusive and just society. During his effort and constant fight for justice, he came across another social activist, Dr.Dinesh Kumar Mishra of Badhmukti Andolan and came together to form a campaign for the organization. Sunil Kumar finally started the MVSK organization for the larger vision of a classless and equitable society against all caste,gender and other social hierarchies.

After the inception, MVSK registered under societies registration act 21 of 1860, FCRA, 12A, 80G, PAN, TAN & CSR. It was registered on 7 March 2027

VISION

MVSK visions for creating a sustainable and equitable society to safeguard dignity and justice for all particularly for the marginalized who are at the lower ladder of development. Our aim is to create a mechanism that could provide an opportunity for all to achieve success without any discrimination. A vision where people can keep their heads high with commitment.

MISSION

The organization has the mission to enlighten the larger section of society and empower them with a dignified life with their constant participation in overall social development. The Organization caters to instill non-violent means to achieve the greater good and the path for an inclusive developmental model for creating and sustaining a just society. The organization has a particular mission to be involved in flood prone areas for capacity-building measures and relief to all marginalized particularly Dalits, women, children, PWD, different vulnerable communities and elderly citizens of the society.

OBJECTIVES

1. To aware poor on development issues and orient them for participation in development process as their rights.
2. To eradicate social evils of illiteracy, un-touchability, gender, caste-region-religion disparity, dowry, drug-addication, superstition & all like these things & to advance reasons to guide our belief- system.
3. To make efforts & interventions for Socio-Economic development of all marginalized groups and improve their health, education, knowledge, skills and resources .
4. To form youth clubs and develop youth as development catalysts.
5. To safeguard Dalits identity and honor their rights and eliminate social violence and disparity, particularly against women.
6. To make efforts for different weaker section of the society like old PWD, sick, children and other vulnerable people to live a dignified life with their entitlement & rights.
7. To explore ways and provide necessary inputs for sustainable agriculture & allied activities & to promote eco-friendly economic activities for better livelihood

8. To act for the promotion of good dynamic local self-governance.
9. To make efforts and community based intervention for preserving and improving local environment & eco system by saving water, land, forest and other local natural resources.
10. To implement DRR, CBDRR, SCHOOL SAFETY PROGRAMME

Organization's Strategies:-

- Maintenance of transparency and accountability .

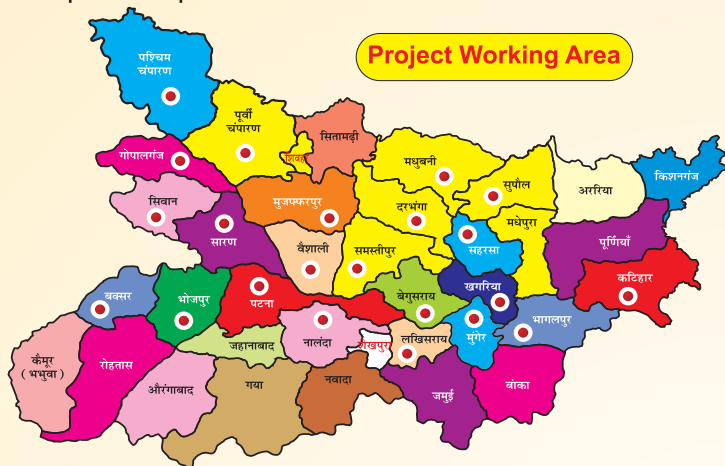
Organization's Methodology: ManavVikas Sanasthan Khairi is a learning organization working at grass root level in poor community. It thoroughly assesses the needs of the communities by participatory methods. We also take views of external advisers and concerned stakeholders. The summary of these inputs are processed and researched by our social scientists. Then we draft an action plan. We discuss the plan with our volunteers as well as with some key beneficiaries. We set milestones & then accordingly we implement plan with beneficiaries' participation and their support in efficient and effective way to achieve the desired objectives & a larger impact at the end of project/activity. Then we share our experiences with others and learn from each other.

Organization's Approaches': ManavVikas Sansthan Khairi works for the capacity building of the people & enhancing the different kinds of leadership among the community around the issues of their concern so that Community itself takes lead in their issues. Our approach is community-centric where people take charge of their issues. Our role is of facilitator. We also strongly belief that it is primary the responsibility of the local government to take care of the needs of the people. thus we organize interface meeting with government & different stakeholders to strengthen local self-governance at Panchayat level. This helps in ensuring the sustainability of community-based organization.

Focus group of MVSK.: MVSK focus group consists of socially & economically marginalized & excluded. Our focused target communities are Women, Children, People with disability (PWD) & old people from:-

- Dalit and Maha-Dalit
- Extremely Backward Community
- Vulnerable group of people like-old men, women and children
- Victims of different disasters
- Marginal farms
- Landless pople and labors
- Dalit women and youth

Working Area : Geographical Area:- MVSK has been working in Bihar for 17 Years with special focus in Madhubani & Darbhanga districts. However, the organization has now expanded its functioning to Samastipur, Madhepura, East Champaran, Supaul and another districts of Bihar.



Our Core thematic areas are:-

- 1. Education:** This includes Pre-Education, Right to Education, Focused is on increasing the enrollment of girl child in the government schools along with boys.
- 2. Women Empowerment:-** Reducing the gender gap, capacity building around gender equality, liberty and justice ,women empowerment & women focused intervention for socio-economic development with livelihood promotion.
- 3. Health -** Improvement in overall community health.Supporting person suffering from Tuberculosis, leprosy,PLHIV and other diseases which are socially stigmatised , capacity building on personal and menstrual hygiene management, awareness & care of COVID-19 symptomatic patients, helping in their rehabilitation.
- 4. WASH-** awareness on WASH and its relation with community health. Building community toilets,bathing cubicle, different non-conventional water lifting devices like play pump, wash basin installation, promotion of public health messages, engaging girl child in different sports activities
- 5. Nutrition:-** Identification of Malnourished children ,women and others.Awareness on nutritious diet locally and easily available. promotion of herbal and nutrition garden for regular supply of healthy and nutritious food like fruit and vegetables.
- 6. Disaster Risk Reduction/Humanitarian Response:-**community based response preparedness, preparation of village disaster management plan, capacity building of Task force, resource mobilisation for CBDRR, rehabilitation of disaster victims by ensuring their entitlement on different government schemes. Response during COVID-19. Support during local flood, fire & other disaster. Supporting reverse migrants, cash transfer during COVID-19, Exclusive disabled inclusive DRR programme.
- 7. Livelihood:-** Sustainable livelihood building resilience among community, introduction of new farm & non-farm-based livelihood.
- 8. Climate changes & Adaptation:-** Community awareness on climate change and its impact at local level. Climate resilient farming and natural resource management.

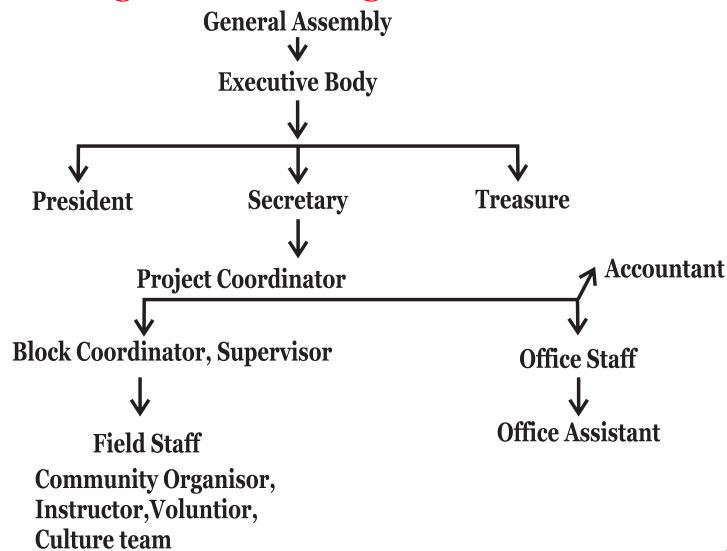
9. Promoting Equality & Dignity for all. awareness programmes on people right for equality,justice and liberty.

Major Program & Achievements

Education:- Establishment of 10 center of Baal Lok Sikshan Kendra. On this center 1000 children get daily (Monday- Saturday) milk and educational activity. We work with 12,000 Girls (7-14Yrs.) for the continuation in the school.



Women Empowerment:- MVSK has 625 SHGS. It has 9000 members who are working as leaders in their community and involved in ensuring women rights on health education, property and government schemes.

CBOs:- MVSK has 125 CBOs of different social groups like farmers club, youth club, WASH Committees, Group of PWDS & adolescent girls & boys.



Health

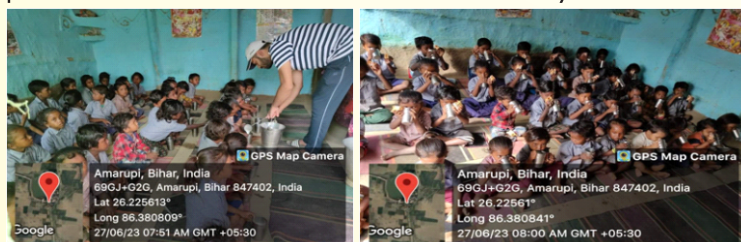
1. Supported 115 person suffering from Tuberculosis, leprosy, capacity building on personal and menstrual hygiene management with 450 adolescent girls. Organised 56 special health camps during flood. Supported 20000 families during COVID-19 patient,
2. Orientation of field staff, 600 ASHA, 150 village volunteer on safe maternal health, nutrition and family planning.



WASH:- MVSK has formed 105 Wash committees in Madhubani, Madhepura and Samastipur district of Bihar. MVSK has supported in the development of school WASH infrastructure like the installation of water filter and solar system as substitute of electricity, installation of play pump, construction of handwash station in 25 schools in Madhubani district. MVSK has installed 3 raised hand-pump with bathing cubical in Jhanjharpur block of Madhubani district. It has helped around 1100- school children to adopt proper WASH practice in their day-to-day life.



Nutrition:- MVSK has established 10 nutrition centres in Madhubani. On these centers MVSK provides 150 ml milk & Parle-G biscuit to 1000 children every day (Monday-Saturday). It has helped them to get additional required nutrition. The organisation also provides food ration to 1000 families two times in a year.



Disaster Risk Reduction/Humanitarian Response:- Formed 50 VDMC & Task force in 50 villages. MVSK has taken community based initiative for disaster preparedness, Village disaster management plan, capacity building of Task force, resource management for VDMP in 50 villages of Madhubani district. It has helped more than 30000 families during flood, fire, Drought, Covid-19

in its working districts. It has supported 5000 migrant families to get the benefit of cash transfer. MVSK provided dry Ration Kit, Wash Kit to 25000HH during Covid-19 Response in Madhubani district of Bihar.



Livelihood:- MVSK works with 9000HH on the sustainable livelihood through farming & animal husbandry. It has formed 2 FPOs in Samstipur district of Bihar for development of entrepreneurship among poor farmers. It has integrated agriculture with animal husbandry for getting leverage from each other & ensure sustainable livelihood for 9000 HHs. Most of them are women headed Dalit families. They are now involved in sustainable livelihood practices. MVSK has helped 15000 people to access entitlement on government schemes. 5000 Un-organized labor are getting benefit of 6000 rupees per year from labor registration card in Madhubani district of Bihar.



Climate changes & Adaptation's:- MVSK runs community level awareness programme on climate change & its impact at local level in 50 villages in Madhubani, Darbhanga & Samstipur districts of Bihar. It is promoting climate resilient farming in these districts. It has opened 10 farmer field schools for adaptation of climate resilient farming. It has taken measures like the promotion of organic farming, creation of traditional climate resilient seed bank, tree plantation, soil and water conservation. It has planted more than 50000 trees. It is running campaign to conserve local indigenous trees, traditional water bodies and soil.
